S. R. O. No. 782/2016.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968), read with section 3 thereof, the Government of Kerala, hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Service Rules, namely:—

RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Service (Seventh Amendment) Rules, 2016.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of the Rules.*—In Appendix X of Part III of the Kerala Service Rules,—

(1) in the proviso under rule 3 Part A of Pension (Commutation) Rules, after the word “judicial” the words “or a departmental” shall be inserted.

(2) in the Note 5 under rule 5A of Part A of Pension (Commutation) Rules, for the word “judicial” the words “judicial/departmental” shall be substituted.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Government vide G.O. (P) No. 34/2006/Fin., dated 20-1-2006 have amended rule 3 of Part A of Pension (Commutation) Rules by deleting the words “or a departmental” as well as substituting Note 5 under rule 5A of Part A of Pension (Commutation) Rules as follows : “On conclusion of judicial proceedings, if there is no punishment, calculation shall be made on the basis of the commutation factor at the time of original application and if there is punishment or reduction of pension, the calculation shall be made on the age at next birthday subsequent to the date of awarding punishment”.

It has come to the notice of the Government that consequent to the amendment there arose a situation wherein a delinquent officer, against whom departmental proceedings are pending could commute his pension before its finalisation and if on the finalisation of such proceedings, the final pension of the delinquent officer is reduced to a minimum, there is no scope for the Government to recover excess paid commuted value from the minimum pension sanctioned. Hence, the Government have decided to modify the proviso under rule 3 Part A of Pension (Commutation) Rules and Note 5 under rule 5A of Part A of Pension (Commutation) Rules. In order to give statutory validity to the above decision, suitable amendment has to be made to Part III of the Kerala Service Rules.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
