ORDER

As per the Government Order 1st read above, Government introduced the system of disbursement of salary and other entitlements of all Gazetted Officers in State Government Service through Treasury Savings Bank Accounts. Thereafter, all Government Employees including Gazetted Officers were permitted to draw their salary and other entitlements through their accounts with Public Sector Banks on optional basis. Subsequent orders in this regard were also issued vide Government Orders read 3rd and 4th above. Hence, presently all gazetted officers are receiving their salary through treasury/bank accounts. But no sanction has been issued so far permitting non gazetted employees to receive salary through TSB accounts.

2. Government have already initiated various steps to provide additional features and facilities for TSB account holders especially in the IFMS scenario. Moreover, electronic transfer of money from TSB account to any bank account is now possible through e-kuber portal of RBI. The IFMS review meeting referred 5th above has discussed the scope of making TSB accounts more attractive and decided to permit all Non Gazetted Officers to open TSB accounts to receive their salary and other entitlements on an optional basis.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to introduce the system of disbursement of salary and other entitlements of all non gazetted officers in the state through Treasury Savings Bank Accounts on optional basis.

4. Director of Treasuries will facilitate the opening of TSB accounts to the State Government Employees under the non gazetted category in all Treasuries on request from such officers. DDOs will process the establishment bills enabling the transfer credit of salary and other entitlements of interested NGOs under him on their written request.


