Pay Revision 2014 - Medical Education Department- Scale of Pay of Store Superintendent and ratio promotion of Pharmacist- Modified - Orders Issued.

ORDER

As per the G.O read as 6th above orders have been issued revising pay and allowances of State Government Employees and Teachers w.e.f 01.07.2014 wherein the scales of pay allowed to the category of posts under Pharmacy Wing of Medical Education and Health services Departments were revised as follows:

The posts of Pharmacists Gr.I and Gr.II were placed in the ratio of 1:1 in Health Services Department and 1:2 in Medical Education Department. The Director, Medical Education Department has reported that prior to the withdrawal of dual control of posts by the Director of Health Service in Medical Education Service, the scale of pay and promotional avenues of posts under Pharmacy Wing were governed by the schedule of posts and scales under Health Services Department in the Pay Revision Orders. But after the withdrawal of dual control, the scale of pay and promotion prospects of the entire posts under Medical Education Department are governed by the schedule of posts specifically provided for Medical Education Department in the Pay Revision Order.

2. In Health Services Department the post of 'Pharmacist Store Keeper' has the posts of 'Stores Superintendent, Hospital', 'Store Superintendent, District Medical Stores' as promotion posts. As per G.O read as 1st above the scale of pay of 'Pharmacist Store Keeper', 'Store Superintendent Hospital' and 'Store Superintendent, District Medical Stores' were placed in the scales of pay of Rs.7990-12930, Rs.8390-13270 and Rs.10790-18000 respectively. As per the G.O read as 2nd above scale of pay of Pharmacist Store Keeper was enhanced to Rs.9190-15510 in compliance with the judgement dated 3.06.2009 of the Hon'ble High Court in WP(C).No.27580/07. Consequently post of Store Superintendent Hospital which is the next promotion post of Pharmacist Store Keeper happened to be on a lower scale of pay of Rs.8390-13270. In the 9th Pay Revision Order the post of Pharmacist Store Keeper and Store Superintendent Hospital in Health Services Department were placed on the same scale of pay of Rs.16180-29180. But in Medical Education Department the post of Store Superintendent was continued on the lower scale of pay of Rs.14620-25280 unaffected by the higher scale of pay given to the same post in Health Services Department.

3. As per G.O read as 5th above, the scale of pay of Store Superintendent, Hospital in Health Services Department was further enhanced to Rs.16980-31360 owing to the reason that it is the promotion post of Pharmacist Store Keeper. Then also the scale of pay of Store Superintendent in Medical Education Department was left unrevised and it was on much lower scale of pay than the scale of pay of feeder post. In the 10th Pay Revision also the post of Store Superintendent in Medical Education Department is placed on a lower scale of pay of Rs.29200-62400.

4. With the withdrawal of dual control of posts, different posts under Pharmacy Wing in Health Services and Medical Education Departments are placed in such a way that the post of Pharmacist Gr.I in Health Services Department has happened to have the promotion posts of Pharmacist Store Keeper on Rs.30700-65400, Store Superintendent Hospital on Rs.32300-68700 and Store Superintendent, District Medical Stores on Rs.35700-75600, whereas in Medical Education Department there are only two promotion posts, ie, Pharmacist Store Keeper on Rs.30700-65400 and Store Superintendent which is on a lower scale of pay of Rs.29200-62400. The Director of Medical Education has requested to rectify the anomalous scale of pay of Rs.29200-62400 attached to the post of Store Superintendent in

Medical Education Department. In the letter read above, the Accountant General has brought to the notice of the Government the practical difficulties in fixing the pay of Store Superintendent in the changed scenario.

5. In the G.O read as 3rd above, the post of Pharmacist Gr.I and Gr.II in Health Services Department and Medical Education Department were placed in the ratio of 1:2. But the ratio was enhanced to 1:1 in Health Services Department alone vide G.O read as 4th above. In the Government Order read as 6th above also, post of Pharmacist Gr.I and Gr.II in Medical Education Department are placed in the ratio 1:2. The Director of Medical Education has reported that assigning a lower ratio for the post of Pharmacist Gr.I and Gr.II in Medical Education Department has no justification on any ground and he has, therefore, requested to modify the ratio between Pharmacist Gr.I and Gr.II at par with the ratio existing in Health Services Department.

6. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to issue the following orders:

(1) The scale of pay of the post of Store Superintendent in Medical Education Department will be modified from Rs.29200-62400 to Rs.35700-75600 w.e.f 01.07.2014.

(2) The ratio between the posts of Pharmacist Gr.I and Gr.II in Medical Education Department will be modified from 1:2 to 1:1 w.e.f 01.04.2016.

7. The arrears of pay arising out of this order will be notional up to 30.06.2017.


