**ORDER**

As per Government Order read as 2<sup>nd</sup> above, orders have been issued revising the pay and allowances of State Government employees and teachers w.e.f 01.07.14 wherein the posts of Deputy Director and Principal, Higher Secondary Education are placed on the same scale of pay of Rs.45800-89000. The post of Deputy Director in Higher Secondary Education Department was created vide G.O read as 1<sup>st</sup> above on a higher scale of pay than that of Principal, Higher Secondary School. The Director, Higher Secondary Education has reported that no Special Rules are in force for appointment to the post of Deputy Director and now appointment is made by placement of senior most Principals. Therefore the appointees to the post of Deputy Director do not stand to gain any benefit of fixation of pay. Hence the Director has recommended to enhance the scale of pay of Deputy Director,

Higher Secondary Education befitting the duties and responsibilities attached to the post.

2. Government have examined the matter in detail. Since the Special Rules prescribing the method of appointment to the post of Deputy Director have not been formulated so far and the appointment to the post is made through placement, the request for a higher scale of pay cannot be allowed. However, taking into account the higher duties and responsibilities attached to the post of Deputy Director, Government are pleased to sanction a Special Allowance of Rs.1100/- p.m. to the post of Deputy Director provided that no Special Allowance will be admissible to those who enjoyed the benefit of pay fixation or advance increment on appointment to the post. As the Special Allowance is in consideration of the higher responsibilities, it will not be admissible during periods of leave and transit.

3. This order will take effect from 01.04.2016.


