Pay Revision 2014 - Career Advancement Scheme - 2nd placement of Medical Officers in Indian Systems of Medicine and Homoeopathy Departments, and Veterinary Surgeons in Animal Husbandry Departments- Scale of Pay Modified - Orders Issued.

ORDER

As per the Government Order read as 1st above, Career Advancement Scheme was introduced for directly recruited professionals to the posts with professional degree as the basic qualification. In the Government Order read as 2nd above, the scheme without any major changes is allowed to continue on the recommendations of the 10th Pay Revision Commission. As per the system of Career Advancement Scheme in vogue, employees are eligible for the scale of pay of the 2nd cadre promotion post on completion of 15 years of service. Accordingly the employees appointed to the post of Medical Officers in Indian Systems of Medicine and Homoeopathy Departments, and Veterinary Surgeon in Animal Husbandry Department are eligible for the scale of pay of Rs.45800-89000 on 2nd placement under Career Advancement Scheme. There has been consistent demand from the above categories for enhancing the scale of pay on placement under Career Advancement Scheme considering their professional qualification and arduous nature of duty.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that Medical Officers in Indian Systems of Medicine and Homoeopathy Departments, and Veterinary Surgeons in Animal Husbandry Department will be sanctioned the scale of pay of Rs.68700-110400 under Career Advancement Scheme on completion of 15 years of service in relaxation of the condition laid down under Para 11(1) in the Government Order read as 2nd above which stipulates that scale of pay of respective promotion post will be allowed on completion of prescribed period of service. In the event of promotion to cadre posts carrying a lower scale of pay after sanction of this

scale, the officer will be allowed to retain the scale and the pay drawn on it even after promotion provided that no benefit of fixation of pay will be allowed on promotion. This order will have effect from 01.02.2016 and the arrears on account of these orders from 01.02.2016 to 31.07.2017 will be notional. All other conditions governing the Career Advancement Scheme will continue to apply.
