ORDER

As per Government Order read as 1st above, orders have been issued revising pay and allowances of State Government Employees and Teachers, wherein it has been ordered that the amount of arrears on account of Pay Revision will be paid in cash in four equal instalments on 01.04.2017, 01.10.2017, 01.04.2018 and 01.10.2018 respectively along with interest on the arrears not drawn as on the above dated at the rate admissible to the General Provident Fund. Later Government have ordered to credit the first and second instalments of pay revision arrears of State Government Employees to the Provident Fund of State Government Employees along with interest vide Government Order read as 3rd and 4th above respectively. As per Government Order read as 2nd above, orders have been issued revising pay and allowances of University Employees of the state except those covered by AICTE/UGC/Central Schemes with effect from 01.07.2014 wherein it has been ordered that the revised pay and allowances will be granted in cash from February, 2016. It has also been ordered that the Universities may decide appropriately on payment of arrears on account of revision of pay and allowances.

Government have reviewed the earlier decision and are now pleased to order that the Universities shall credit pay revision arrears in respect of University employees to their respective Provident Fund Account.


