ORDER

Government in its order read as 1st paper above fixed the rate of Travelling Expenses of Chairman (Part-time/Full-time)/Chief Executives/Non-Official Directors and Employees of PSUs/Statutory Boards/Corporations/Other Autonomous Institutions under the control of Government of Kerala on par with that for the Government employees.

2. As per Government order read 2nd paper above, the Government have revised the TA/DA rates of State Government employees with effect from 1-3-2006.

3. Government are now pleased to order that the revised rates of Travelling Allowance ordered vide Government Order read 2nd will also be applicable to Chairman (Part-time/Full-time)/Chief Executives/Non-Official Directors and Employees of PSUs/Boards/Autonomous Institutions etc., under the control of the Government of Kerala.

4. The ceiling limit for TA of officers prescribed in G. O. read as 3rd paper above as detailed in the statement appended will continue.

5. Since the concessional rate of room rent in Government Guest House, Rest House, etc., is not admissible to the employees of Public Sector Undertakings etc., on the same lines as for State Government employees, the Board of Directors of Public Sector Undertaking, Board, Autonomous Institution, Statutory Agency, etc., may if necessary allow a marginal increase of up to 15% over and above the admissible rate of Daily Allowance only. The monthly ceiling limits indicated in Annexure to the Government Order read 3rd paper above may also be enhanced marginally, not exceeding 15%.

6. Government also order that any deviation from the ceiling limit for TA prescribed in the Government Order requires prior approval of Government, even if there are separate Government Orders authorizing deviations from the Government TA/DA rates for specific Public Sector Undertakings, etc.
