Kerala Service Rules Part III- Service put in by an employee in one University and subsequently joined another University as fresh appointment - Reckoning for pension - orders issued.

<u>ORDER</u>

As per Government Order read as first paper above, order was issued to reckon part service put in by Government employees in Universities viz. Kerala University, Calicut University, Mahatma Gandhi University, SreeSankara University, Kannur University, Cochin University of Science and Technology and Kerala Agricultural University prior to their entry into the State Service as Qualifying Service for pensionary benefits subject to the payment of pensionary liability by the former employer. In the Government Order read 2nd above, order was issued to dispense with the payment of prorata pensionary liability in the case of employees who left the former service in Panchayath/ Municipal Common Service and University to join Government Service including aided school and vice versa.

The Registrar, University of Kerala in his letter read above had sought clarification as to whether the rule is applicable to employees who have put

in prior service in Universities and subsequently joined another University as fresh hand.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order the following.

- 1. The prior service put in by an employee in one University before joining another University on fresh appointment shall be reckoned for pensionary benefits in the latter University.
- The payment of pension liability will not be insisted upon as it is a reciprocal arrangement between the Universities and often the liability is met by the Universities from the Grant-in Aid of State Government sanctioned for pay and allowances. The Universities mentioned above shall incorporate this provision in their statutes through necessary amendments.
