ORDER

As per the Government Order read above, sanction has been accorded for the constitution of Public Policy Research Institute at Thiruvananthapuram to serve as a centre for production and dissemination of knowledge in the field of public policy management by giving special attention to under take multi- disciplinary research and documentation on the issues faced by Kerala Society and economy as announced in the budget speech 2012-13 and Dr.Jose Jacob was appointed as the Special Officer of public Policy Research Institute.

Dr. Jose Jacob, the Special Officer, submitted a Detailed Project Report regarding the constitution of Public Policy Research Institute for the approval of Government. The State Planning Board examined the project report and offered their views .

Government have examined the Project Report furnished by the Special Officer, in detail and are pleased to approve the same subject to the following modifications.

- (i). A regular Director must be appointed for the Public Policy Research Institute. The Director should have Ph.D degree in Public Economics /Public Administration/Public Policy, a minimum of 15 years post academic administrative cum research experience and published works. The details of pay and allowances, terms and conditions of service, suitability etc will be recommended by the experts in the Governing Body.
- (ii). All possible efforts shall be made to obtain funds from Government of India, agencies like Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR). and bilateral and multi- lateral donor agencies to create the Corpus Fund for the Institute .
- (iii). An action plan with activity calendar with monitorable targets must be

prepared before starting functioning of the institute. Government fund should provide only after the approval of action plan by Government.

(iv). The Corpus Fund and non plan provision will be provided only after a thorough scrutiny of the proposal furnished by Special Officer .

Dr. Jose Jacob, Special Officer, PPRI is appointed as the Director of Public Policy Research Institute till the appointment of a new Director.


