Sub:- Misuse of Indian Currency Notes - Instructions issued.

Ref:- Press Release dated September 11, 2013 of the Reserve Bank of India.

The Reserve Bank of India, vide its Press Release under reference, appealed to the General Public to respect the Indian currency as they are a symbol of the Sovereign. The Public, Institutions and others have, therefore, been requested to abstain from misusing the Indian currency notes and to desist from using it for making garlands, for showering on personalities in social events, decorating pandals and places of worship, etc as it will deface the banknotes and shorten its life.

2. With a view of adopting and implementing the RBI policy in this regard, all the Government Departments/Agencies, Public Sector Undertakings, Autonomous Institutions etc are hereby directed to ensure that the currency notes are not misused and are treated with utmost respect.

3. These instructions are to be complied with strictly.


