Sub:- Special Development Fund for MLAs –Administrative Sanction  
to the works proposed under the Scheme – Instructions issued.

At present, members of the State Legislative Assembly (MLAs) including the nominated Members, are entitled for a Special Development Fund at the rate of Rs.75 lakh (per MLA) per annum, vide Government Orders read 2<sup>nd</sup> above. This amount is allotted to the District Collectors in 2 or 3 instalments. It has been brought to the notice of the Government by some <sup>of</sup> Members of the Legislative Assembly that administrative sanctions are being restricted to the extent of funds released by the Government causing delay in taking up the works. The Government having considered the issue are pleased to clarify that Administrative Sanction to the extent of Rs.75 lakh per Constituency can be issued in a fiscal year even if formal sanction for release of the entire budget provision to the SDF of MLAs is not issued.
