ORDER

Rule 280, Kerala Treasury Code, Volume I stipulates that continued existence of pensioners shall be ensured in order to prevent payment of any fraudulent claims. For this purpose, the Pension Disbursing Officers shall require each pensioner either to attend in person at the treasury for due identification at least once in a year or to produce an annual life certificate from persons other than those who usually furnish life certificates for receiving monthly pension.

2. Now the Secretary, Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India vide letter read above has suggested to consider that all State Government employees retiring henceforth may be enrolled on Jeevan Pramaan Portal as part of the process of settlement of pensionary dues. The meeting referred above has resolved to consider adoption of Jeevan Pramaan Portal for State pensioners and accordingly following instructions are issued.

- (i) State Government Pensioners, who are required to attend in person at the treasury for due identification at least once in a year / who are to produce annual life certificate can make use of the Jeevan Pramaan Portal for proving their continued existence.
- (ii) All Treasuries and Akshaya Centres in the State shall facilitate enrollment on Jeevan Praman Portal and issuance of Digital Life Certificate.
- (iii) The Director of Treasuries shall issue suitable instructions to all treasury officers to treat the digital life certificates generated from Jeevan Pramaan Portal as the proof of continued existence of pensioners.
