## ORDER

The Finance Inspection Wing (Technical & Non-Technical) conduct inspections including surprise inspection of Government offices and report to Government cases of irregularities, slackness or indifference in the matter of financial control. The Technical Wing enables Government to have a close and continuous check over the quality of work executed by the technical departments of Government. The Technical and Non-Technical Wings have been assigned specific duties in this regard and they have jurisdiction over Government owned Corporations, Boards and other similar institutions.

- 2. The enquiry reports of the wings are furnished to the concerned Administrative Departments to take necessary action based on the findings and recommendations in the report. It is the responsibility of the Administrative Departments to ensure that speedy and effective action is taken on the reports.
- 3. It has however, come to the notice of Government that in several cases action was not taken on the reports of the Inspection Wings, Government direct that on receipt of the enquiry reports of the Finance Inspection Wings (Technical & Non-Technical) the Department concerned shall take action straightaway and report the nature of action taken (including whether the delinquents have been placed under suspension) to the Inspection Wing within a period of two weeks positively.
- 4. Secretaries to Government and Heads of Departments will ensure strict compliance with the above instructions.
